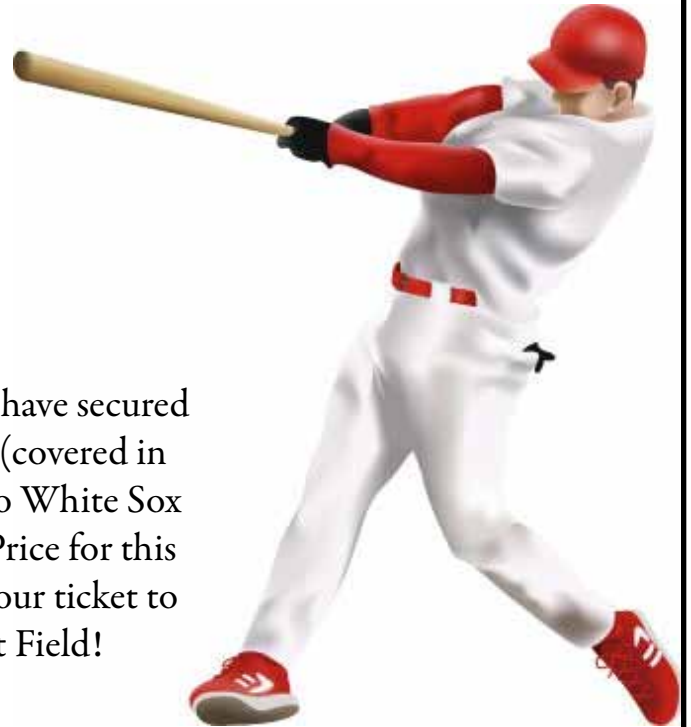


"BYE BYE BIRDIE" AT THE CHANHASSEN \$109.00 PER PERSON
